New improvements in our quality testing laboratory

At Saikang Medical we continue to invest in equipment to complete our quality testing laboratory. Thus, we not only continue to guarantee that our certified products meet all standards, but also provide us with one of our production objectives, which is innovation for the continuous improvement of our products and components.

With the latest implementations, the experts in our quality department have a widening range of methods for control and anticipation: Webster and Rockwell hardness tests (to measure the hardness of aluminum, iron and steel and thus guarantee the quality of the metal parts of our products, such as the chassis, platform or guardrails of our hospital beds), air spring test, IV pole load capacity test, color difference test (whether for plastic, paint, ink printing or fabric), head and foot board tail stress test, 10° slope test (for the correct fastening of wheels and bed brakes on a sloping surface), coating thickness test, cross-cut test (to measure the resistance of paints on the bed surface), motor mounting seat test (to ensure the stability of a correct motor mount), electric bed function test, castor test (standard abrasion resistance for wheels under heavy load), threshold test (with obstacles to check mobility under loads), salt spray test (to measure the durability of metal parts) and vibration platform for packaging (to simulate transport conditions and ensure safe shipping of our products).



In the images, some of the tests that are carried out, such as the vibration platform for packaging, loads and weight mobility, strength and durability of all the components (such as the ends and wheels), etc.

This health center belongs to the Nexus Hospitals group and is northern Perth's newest private day surgery. According to the heads of the center, "has been purpose built for short stay surgery, both day and overnight paediatric and adult patients, and provide a warm and welcoming environment with the latest technology and a highly specialised surgery staff".

In brief

Vitamin D seems to help against Covid-19

A new study has found an association between low vitamin D levels and high amounts of Covid-19 cases (and associated death rates), in 20 European countries. The research has been led by Dr. Lee Smith of Anglia Ruskin University and Dr. Petre Cristian Ilie of QEHL (Queen Elizabeth Hospital Kings Lynn NHS Trust), both entities in the UK. The human body can obtain vitamin D by exposure to sunlight, diet, or supplements. Previous observational studies noted an association between low vitamin D levels and susceptibility to acute respiratory tract infections. The SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus is known to cause excess proinflammatory cytokines.
